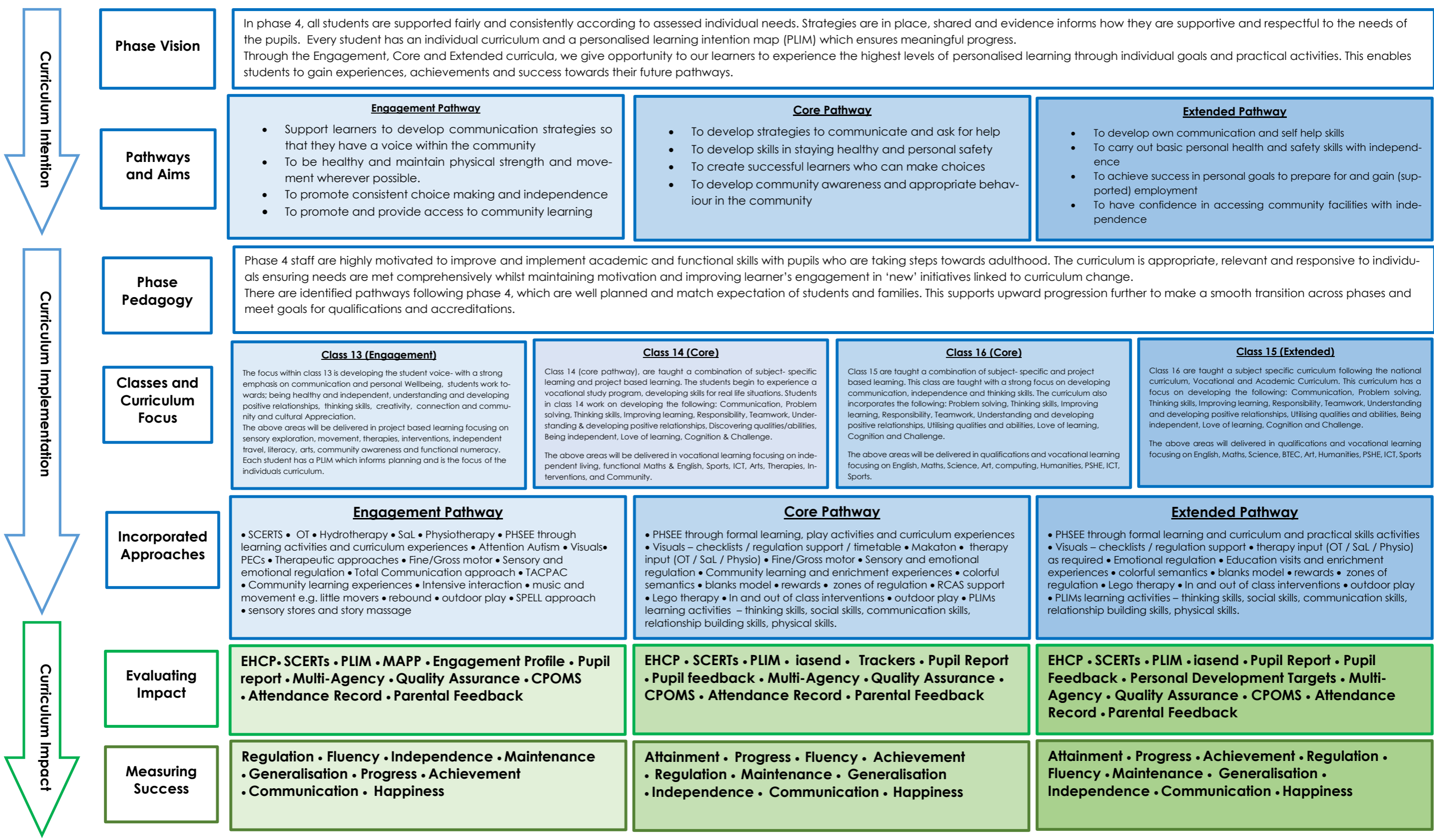


Phase 4 Curriculum Flow [21-22]

Transition into Phase: Students transition into Phase 4 from Phase 3, following the pathway which best suits their individual needs. Students are grouped according to age, ability stage and appropriate peer group. The students in Phase 4 form a predominantly KS 3 cohort. Moving on from KS 2 the students continue to build on prior knowledge and learning whilst being introduced to a curriculum which has more of a focus on preparing them for adulthood.



Transition out of Phase: Students transition from Phase 4 into Phase 5. Phase 5 follows on from Phase 4 pathways and aims, incorporating plans and expectations to ensure students are equipped for the next stage of their independence/education. Phase 5 continues to prepare learners with social confidence and enquiry based mindset ready for life post Cleaswell.
