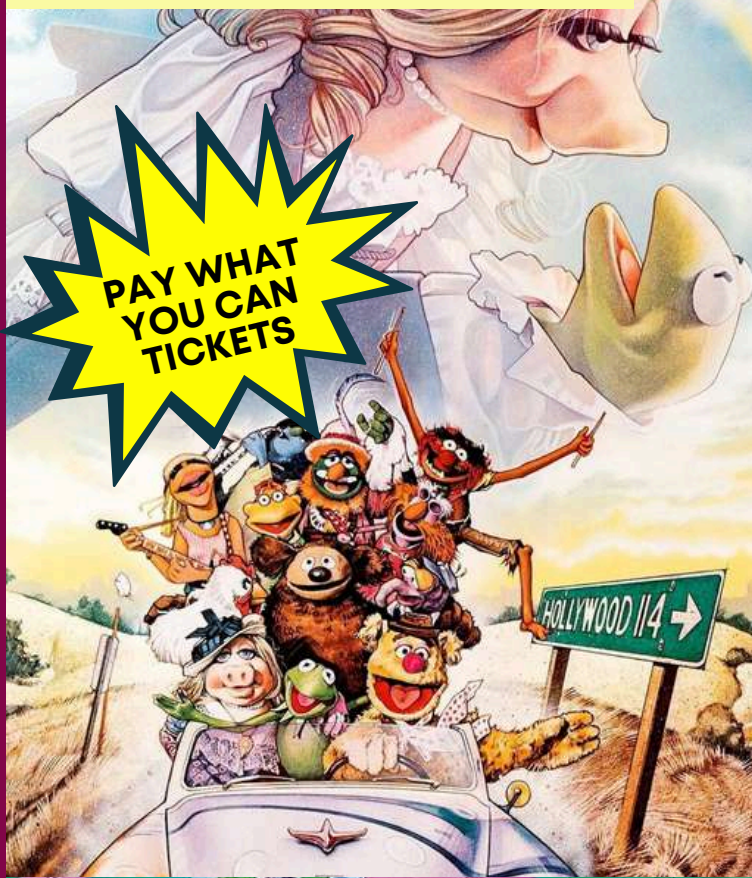

**Content Notes:** Classed as suitable for ages 12+. Infrequent strong language, brief moderate violence, bloody images.



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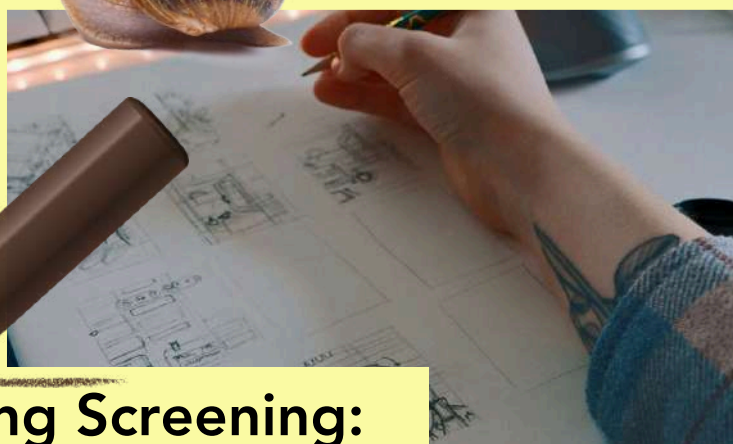

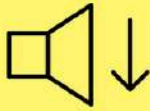
## What to expect at the Relaxed Screenings
