We met with Jenny Smith to look at Cleaswell Hills approach to the pupil's personal development.			
Governor Observations and Comments			
<p>Cleaswell is driven by the belief that every child deserves exceptional learning experiences that support both academic and personal growth. Central to this vision are the Enrichment Passports, which underpin an inclusive curriculum by offering all pupils access to diverse, meaningful activities that broaden horizons, raise aspirations, and build cultural capital. Launched last academic year, the passports are now clearly supporting pupil development.</p> <p>This term, pupil voice is being strengthened through a new partnership with the Local Authority Participation Team, helping children understand the value of their voice both in school and the wider community.</p> <p>Cleaswell continues to work closely with school health teams and families to promote healthier lifestyles. Every pupil receives a Magic Breakfast each day, supporting wellbeing and readiness to learn, with healthy choices encouraged throughout the school day.</p> <p>The Food and Nutrition curriculum is tailored across three pathways:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Engagement Pathway: Pupils explore food through sensory play, integrated into areas like Sensology and Attention Autism. • Core Pathway: Pupils build life skills such as using cutlery and preparing snacks, with tasting activities supporting communication and independence. • Extended Pathway: Pupils deepen their nutritional understanding and gain work experience and accreditations, preparing for future employment. <p>Cleaswell's after-school club offer now runs four days a week across all pathways, providing enriching extracurricular opportunities in music, crafts, sports, and pupil voice. Daily lunch clubs further enhance social engagement and skill development.</p>
