Our dedicated staff team is committed to the provision of a highly supportive, specialised learning environment within which all members of the school community can thrive. Every child at Cleaswell Hill School follows a personalised, broad and responsive curriculum that is appropriate to their age and stage of development, delivered within a positive, safe and stimulating setting.

Cleaswell Hill School aims to appoint an enthusiastic cleaner to join our dynamic staff team. The successful candidate will clean designated areas to ensure that the school is maintained in a safe and hygienic condition. No prior knowledge, qualifications or experience are required; training will be provided.

This post is for a variable hours contract between 7.5 - 15 hours per week. The post is initially for 12.5 hours per week term time + 3 teacher training days. The start date of this post can be negotiated, however the successful candidate will preferably start as soon as possible.

Cleaswell Hill School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff members and volunteers to share this commitment. This post is exempt from the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 and the successful applicant will be required to apply for an Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) certificate, along with other relevant pre-employment checks. As the post will involve regulated activity with children, it is a criminal offence to apply for this post if you are included on the children's barred list held by the DBS.
